The Guidelines for Ride-Outs are recommendations only.

- As a road user you have a responsibility to observe the Highway Code as well as all relevant legal and statutory obligations associated with riding a machine on the public highway.
- It is your responsibility ensure that you are sufficiently skilled to take part in a ride-out.
- At all times you have the sole and ultimate responsibility for your own safety and that of any passengers. If at any time you feel that an act if performed by you would be rash, unsafe or unlawful then you should not do it.
- You have a duty of care to your fellow riders, to other road users and to pedestrians to act in a safe and responsible manner.
- You join a ride-out at your own risk and HOG, Oxford UK Chapter Committee members, Road Captains and any other persons associated with the organisation of ride-outs in general can take no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons or property howsoever caused.
